we are more interested in showing in pop-up and non-traditional spaces. we have roots as a collective. we do not operate within the status quo. we encourage our members to think outside the box and come up with their own identities as creators, and to not simply adopt the industries' ideas and standards.

galleryELL's mission:

1. to form a platform for artists to market themselves.
2. to form a group of active artists who are concerned with more than just their daily practice - who reach out to the community at large.
3. to increase the public's interaction with art and artist by way of a transient model.

galleryELL was founded in 2008 by john ros and launched in july 2009. since our inception, galleryELL has become more recognizable in the art world. a strong online presence increases our daily visibility, and physical exhibitions bring the galleryELL vision into reality.
